Action item 3: Correct program shortcomings and identify opportunities to improve Whenever a problem is identified in any part of the safety and health program, employers—in coordination with supervisors, managers, and workers—should take prompt action to correct the problem and prevent its recurrence.

Process evaluation: Process evaluation is a type of formative evaluation that assesses the type, quantity, and quality of program activities or services. Outcome evaluation: Outcome evaluation can focus on short- and long-term program objectives. Appropriate measures demonstrate changes in health conditions, quality of life, and behaviors.
