□ Many users of Stata seem to have been reluctant to adopt the margins command. □ The manual entry is long, the options are daunting, the output is sometimes unintelligible, and the advantages over older and simpler commands like `adjust` and `mfex` are not always understood

test, we could have arrived at the same results by running margins with honors included in the dydx option. For categorical variables the dydx option calculates discrete change. The output for this approach is in terms of z-scores. By squaring the z-scores we can compare the results to the test
